Dear Friend of Mohican:

The State of Ohio has authorized and virtually mandated drilling and timbering in all state parks and forests, no exceptions. If you want to study an eight page summary of the legislation that created this mandate as of September 30, 2011, send your request to ericmiller@neo.rr.com.

It is a fact that all legislative hurdles to drilling and timbering Mohican State Forest, Mohican State Park and Malabar Farm State Park have been eliminated. Nonetheless, Ohio Division of Natural Resources (ODNR) can still refrain from devastating these priceless local parks. You can help protect the Mohican Complex by contacting local officials, township trustees, school boards, village council, city council, county commissioners, health department boards, or any other public board you care to approach. Ask them to adopt the attached non-binding resolution.

At this point, our best hope to stop the Mohican Complex from being fracked or timbered is to generate enough public support for Mohican that ODNR will voluntarily refrain from signing leases. We are asking you to go to these local government bodies, not because they can stop ODNR (they can't) but because they can help you generate a public outcry that will prompt ODNR to voluntarily refrain from leasing these properties to the timber or fracking industries.
